### **GROUD RULES FOR ONLINE CLASSROOM**



#### Participate:

- a. Show up a few minutes before class time and wait to be admitted into the class. Join with your **video on**.
- b. Find a quiet place free of distractions (siblings, TV, parents, pets, etc)
- c. Provide insightful commentary in the online discussions.
- d. Any communications with your instructor or fellow students are best handled through **email**.
- e. Only post on the **classroom discussion board** if the conversation is relevant to others in the class.
- f. Review all discussion postings before posting your own to **prevent redundancy**.
- g. Avoid taking phone calls, paying online games and having conversations in these shared spaces.



#### **Respect Diversity:**

- a. Be respectful at all times.
- b. Stay on "Mute". If you have a question or something to share, click the "Raise Hand" button and state your name to be acknowledged.
- c. Profanity will not be tolerated. Offensive language must be avoided.
- d. Criticism must be constructive, well-meaning, and well-articulated.
- e. Remember to say "Please" and "Thank you" as appropriate.



## **Proper writing style:**

- a. Correct spelling, grammar, and style are expected in all scholarship and academic writing.
- b. Be aware that typing in **all capital letters indicates shouting** could indicate shouting or emphasis.
- c. **Acronyms** (LOL, etc.) and **emoticons** (smilies) are commonly used online, but be careful not to overuse them.



# Help others:

- a. Respect the **privacy** of your classmates and what they share in class. Never do anything to publicly embarrass anyone online.
- b. Derogatory and sarcastic comments (ex., name-calling, cursing) and jokes are unacceptable.
