

## Online Accessibility Tools for Students Requiring Accommodations

Students who require additional accommodations to access learning, need to utilize the following tools to ensure they are able to adequately access instruction. Please reach out to me if you have additional questions on how to access any of the accessibility tools.

Most common IEP instructional/testing accommodations:	How can this accommodation be delivered virtually?
Verbatim Reading/Text to Speech	<p><b>Read/Write:</b> Extension that is on all Chromebook- Click <a href="#">here</a> for more information</p> <p><b>Learning Ally:</b> SWDs can access a large library of audio books. <i>Reach out to your IEP Case Manager for more information.</i></p> <p><b>ChromeVox:</b> Free online screen reader can be accessed from all devices.</p> <p>Closed Caption option can be turned on for Google Slides you read along with the presenter/presentation,</p>
Calculator	Basic function calculator is already embedded on Chromebooks; scientific calculators can be installed on Chromebooks.
Graphing Calculators	Desmos Graphing Calculator extension can be added for students in HS math courses. You can also access it online : <a href="https://www.desmos.com/calculator?lang=en">https://www.desmos.com/calculator?lang=en</a>
Scribe	<b>Voice Typing</b> is available in Google Docs, automatically transcribes students' voice to text.

Notes and Outlines	Can be provided by classroom teachers and uploaded to the Google classroom.
Extended Time	<p>Teachers can assign a different due date for SWDs depending on the amount of extended time indicated in students' plans: 50% or 100%.</p> <p><b>OR</b></p> <p>Teachers can accept work late for SWDs according to their allowable extended time.</p>

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Frequent Breaks	Turn off your camera take a quick break 2 minute and then come back and join instruction.
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
